How did Barbados communicate?



People in Barbados had various forms of communication as early as the 1840s. Some of the earliest expressions of inter-island communication included a number of signal stations built along the high points of the island to relay messages towards the Saint Ann's Garrison on the south-west coast. This method was used to transmit acts of transgression towards the island.

What services are available in Barbados?

Telecommunications services in Barbados are provided by: LIME, Digicel, Sunbeach, WIISCOM. Telephone services are provided by LIME (Incumbent), Digicel, Sunbeach, and WIISCOM. Internet services are provided by CariAccess, CaribSurf, Neptune Communications, Sunbeach Communications, TeleBarbados /Freemotion.bb, and WI-NET INC. ADSL services are widely available, as are Frame Relay and other more advanced services.




